CONSTITUTION Women's Cl

Article I - Name

This organization shall be known as The Ottawa University Women's Club.

Article II - Purpose

The purpose of the Ottawa University Women's Club is to provide a means of furthering friendly relations among members through relations among members through social contact, to provide entersocial contact, to provide entersocial contact, to provide entersocial contact, to provide tainment and instruction by the tainment and instruction by the presentation of simple but stimpresentation of simple but stimple ulating programs, and to provide an opportunity for campus and community service through the organization as a unit.

Article III - Membership

Section 1. Active membership shall consist of women who are faculty members; house directors;

Section 2. Honorary membership may be conferred upon retired members by unanimous vote of the club upor recommendation of the membership committee.

Article IV - Officers

Section 1. The officers shall be president, vice-president, secret and treasurer.

Section 2. Officers shall be nominated by a committee appointed t

Section 4. Nominations to fill vacancies in office shall be made by the remaining members of the executive committee and acted upon by the club.

Section 5. The executive board shall consist of the elected officers, the chairmen of the officers, the chairmen of the standing committees and the wife of the president of Ottawa University. It shall meet at the call of the president to formulate the officers, to make recommendations, budget, to make recommendations, transact any business of emergency nature and business not of sufficient importance to bring before the club.

Section 3. A scholarship may be awarded to the same student as often as the Scholarship Commit-

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sotion 4. The Scholarship committee shal consider a student for the scholarship if she meets the following require-

- 1. She must have a grade average of 1.5 or better. 2. She must establish evidence
- 3. She must have an accept-
- able personality and a neat appearance.
- 4. She must strive to uphold and enhance the fine spirit of Ottawa Universit

Article VI - Quorum

Two thirds of the membership shall constitute a quorum.

Article VII - Amendments

This constitution may be amended at any regular meeting of the club by a two-thirds vote of the members present upon recommendation of the executive committee.

Article I - Duties of Offic

section 1. The president shall Il preside at all business meetings, (2) serve as chairman of the executive committee, (3) appoint all committees and be ex-officio member of them with the right to vote.

Section 2. The vice-president shall preside in the absence or at the request of the president and serve as chairman of the program committee.

Section 2. The secretary shall keep a record of proceedings of all club meetings and executive board meetings, keep an accurate classified list of the membershi and be responsible for all publicity and correspondence.

Section 4. The treasurer shall receive and keep a record of all funds, make disbursements in

secordance with the budget and send notices of delinquent dues.

Article II - Committees

Section 1. The program committee shall include the vice-president the wife of the president of the University as an ex-officio member, and four other members. It shall be the duty of the program committee to plan the year's program and prepare the year book.

section 2. The membership committee shall consist of three members whose duty it shall be (1) to compile a membership list to be included in the year book, and (2) present new names for active or honorary membership. One member of this committee shall be retained each year.

Section 2. The courtesy committee comprising three members shall, upon appropriate occasions,

Section 4. The Scholarship Comaltiee, composed of the presiden of the Ottawa University Women's club, the Dean of Women of Ottawa University, the wife of the President of Ottawa University, and one member elected by the club, shall choose, from lists available in the Business and Personnel offices, a suitable candidate for the scholarship.

section 5. The size of the Telephone Committee shall be related to the size of the club membership. The duty of this committee shall be to contact the members of the club when necessary.

Article III - Dues

Section 1. The annual dues of active members shall be \$4.00.

Article IV - Meetings

Section 1. The club shall hold regular meetings on the first wednesday of each month at 8:00 P. M., October through May.

Section 2. A called business meeting may be held upon the recomendation of the executive committee.

Article V - Budget

Section 1. The annual budget shall be prepared by the Executive Board and shall be included in the yearbook.

It is the policy of the Ottawa University Women's Club that the hostess fee be not more than \$1.50 per person.
