"I Give You What I Have"

Two Disciples on Their Way to Prayer

① Come on Knees at the Door to Worship.

- All kinds of unexpected things can happen.
- If we are aware.

② Wesley's Hour at Aldersgate

- He went unwillingly.
- Heard Martin Luther's commentary read.

③ How Is It With You in Worship?

- Do we look in here distracted and hurried?
- Are we frustrated by the affairs of life?
- Does our mind wander from one thing to another?
- Some Great Need, some New Impulse or Decision could stir within you.

The Helpless Man at The Gate

① He Had To Be Carried

- Who carries him? - Parents, friends.
- What kind of altitude? -
On a hot day, cold day, rainy day -

② This Man Had To Beg

- Take the Scraps, the Left Overs,
the Condensation, the Anger.
- Always Having the Superficial Needs
and never the Deep, Inner Needs

③ The Helplessness of Us All

- Not Simply The Physical
- But The Emotional Needs
 - Inferiority
 - Loneliness
 - Fear
- The Spiritual Needs of Life.
 - Guilt
 - drifting and search for meaning.

These Two Disciples Have The Best They Have

① They Start With Money

- We Always Start With The Obvious.
 - "He needs to be put on relief"
 - "Give them some old clothes"
 - "Send them to the old folks home"
 - "Give them a farm"

- Many times people are looking for Jesus Deeper.
- I have come to ask about my husband or daughter - "I want help for myself"
- They hang around your house because they're lonely.
- They have come about some little physical matter, but they have a great spiritual need.

② Peter and John Now Come To The Depth of Need.

- There are no physical resources, but great spiritual resources.
- Perhaps they remembered that incident of men being lowered through the roof.
- This man needed Healing - Belongance
- He needs what they can share with him?

"I Give You What I Have"

"In the Name of Jesus Christ, Rise, Walk"

- Here was the greatest healing they could share.

③ Then They Were With Jesus

- Saw His Love and Power
- Saw the kindness of Deep Faith.
- Then had learned of Him.

② They Had Passed Through The Death and Disconnection.

- Known The Anguish of Defeat
- The Power of Victory.

③ That They Had Been Through Pentecost

- Now It Was The Inner Cross.
- He Had Shared His Life With Them.
 - Intimately and Personally.
 - In Truth They Had Received.
 - So Life, Love and Joy Had Come.
- This They Shared With The Keepers Also.

④ Now This Man Received As They Had Received

- He Came Willing, Leaving and Bringing ^{God.}
- He Gave Them Into All kinds of Wonderful Trouble.
 - Argument, Witness, Condemnation and 5,000 Believers
