Dear Dr Smith:

The month of June has been a very busy one with me, having made calls in some 40 of the Kansas Counties and traveled some I wanted to consult my wife relative to the 2400 miles. While I would prefer to have another personal talk with you before deciding es this matter I do not think I will be able to see you for some weeks and feel that I should give you my decision one way or the other without further delay and, therefore, if you are willing to take me as I am, I assure you that I will do the best I can which may fall very far short of what you expect, I am willing to ascept the responsibility.

I desire to thank you and the Board for the honor conferred on me by reason of the appointment, or rather the election to the Board.


