Monday afternoon September 2nd 1907

The faculty met informally at two o'clock and discussed the schedule of classes for the fall semester. The schedule as revised was adopted and ordered printed.

After further informal discussion as to the days of the week on which certain classes should meet, the understanding being that in general three hour courses should meet on Tues. Thurs. and Sat, and two hour courses on Wed and Fri., the faculty dispersed.

Monday afternoon Sept 9th 1907.

Present Messrs Price, Chandler, Wilson, Hill, Shirk, Foster, Groner and Gordis and Misses Pirscher, Edgerton and Shivers.

Meeting opened with prayer President Price leading.

Minutes of meetings of May 23rd and Sept. 2nd read and approved.

Professor Wilson for the Registration committee presented certain requests of students to take more than the regular amount of work.

The request of Miss Mary Burk to take ancient history in addition to the regular work of the middle academic year was granted on motion of Professor Wilson.

The request of Mr. Henry Frowning to take 20 hours work was reported but action was deferred in view of his probable work as modern language assistant.

The request of Mr. Leslie Ferris to take 20 hours, since this amount of work is necessary to enable him to finish the course with his class, was granted on motion of Professor Wilson.

On motion of Professors Wilson and Gordis it was voted to grant

Miss Jessie Stewart's request to register for nineteen hours in order to make up for enforced absence part of last year.

On motion of Professor Wilson and Miss Edgerton Miss Olive Lynch was permitted to register for nineteen hours work, that she might gain the extra five hours requiring of candidates for the state teachers' certificate.

Miss Pearl Daily's request was to register for 19 hours, and also to substitute second year German for sophomore Latin, since the Latin - 2 hours - conflicts with a five hour English course which she needs in order to get the requisite number of hours of available work, and since the German course would for the year give four semesters hours foreign language than the Latin displaced, the request was granted on the motion of Professors Gordis and Wilson.

Mr. Elay Dalis request to register for more than the normal number of hours was on motion of Professors Chandler and Fenter referred to the Registration Com. with power to act.

On motion of Professors Wilson and Gordis, Mr. Earl Rugh was permitted to register for 19 hours.

Mr. Mc Nutt's request to substitute Oratory for Vigil, five hours was referred to the Registration Com.

Professor Wilson suggested certain rules regarding the reports of teachers to the Registrar as follows:

I. All teachers' reports to the Registrar, regular or special, must be made in ink on the report blanks furnished by the institution.

II. If a student is reported conditions and the condition is removed afterwards, the instructor involved shall report it in his own hand-writing, giving date in the column of remarks on the original report sheet and calling the Registrar's attention to the fact.

The rules were adopted on motion of Professors Wilson and Hill.
