CONSTITUTION

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Article I - Name

This organization shall be known as The Ottawa University Women's Club.

Article II - Purpose

The purpose of the Ottawa University Women's Club is to provide a means of furthering friendly relations among members through social contact, to provide entertainment and instruction by the presentation of simple but stimulating programs, and to provide an opportunity for campus and community service through the organization as a unit.

Article III - Membership

Section 1. Active membership shall be open to all women who are affiliated with the University in administrative, faculty, or staff capacities, or whose husbands are so affiliated.

Section 2. Membership shall not be open to students, or to employees of the University except as this status is incidental to their eligibility as set forth above.

Section 3. Upon retirement, active members shall be placed on the honorary membership roll. Honorary membership may be conferred upon others, after the recommendation of the Membership and Executive Committees by unanimous approval of the Club.

Article IV - Meetings

Section 1. The club shall hold regular meetings on the first Wednesday of each month at 8:00 P.M.,

October through May.

Section 2. A called business meeting may be held up on the recommendation of the executive committee.

Article V - Budget

Section 1. The annual budget shall be prepared by the Executive Board and reported to the club at the beginning of the year.

By-Laws

Article I - Duties of Officers

Section 1. The president shall: preside at all business meetings; serve as chairman of the Executive Committee; appoint all committees and be ex-officio member of them with the right to vote.

Section 2. The vice-president shall preside in the absence or at the request of the president and serve as chairman of the Program Committee.

Section 3. The secretary shall keep a record of proceedings of all club meetings and executive board meetings, keep an accurate classified list of the membership and be responsible for all publicity and correspondence.

Section 4. The treasurer shall receive and keep a record of all funds, make disbursements in accordance with the budget and send notices of delinquent dues.

Article II - Committees

Section 1. The Program Committee shall include the vice-president as chairman, the wife of the president of the University as an ex-officio member, and four other members. It shall be the duty of the

Program Committee to plan the year's program and prepare the yearbook.

Section 2. The Membership Committee shall consist of three members, one of whom shall have served the previous year. The duties of this committee shall be: 1) to determine the roll of active membership; 2) in conjunction with the Executive Committee to make recommendations for any honorary memberships other than of retired members; 3) to compile a complete list of the members to be included in the yearbook. This committee shall also notify new members and present them to the Club.

Section 3. The Courtesy Committee, comprising three members, shall, upon appropriate occasions, express the sentiment of the Club.

Section 4. The Scholarship Committee, composed of the president of the Ottawa University Women's Club, the Dean of Women of Ottawa University, the wife of

the president of Ottawa University, and one member elected by the Club, shall choose, from lists available in the Business and Personnel offices, a suitable candidate for the scholarship.

Section 5. The size of the Telephone Committee shall be related to the size of the Club membership. The duty of this committee shall be to contact the members of the Club when necessary.

Article III - Dues

Section 1. The annual dues of active members shall be four dollars.

Section 2. Members failing to pay shall be reminded by the treasurer.

Article IV - Officers

Section 1. The officers shall be president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer.

Section 2. Officers shall be nominated by a committee appointed by the president at the March meeting. Election shall take place at the April meeting and shall be by oral vote, a majority of those present being necessary to elect.

Section 3. Officers shall be elected for a term of one year, beginning June 1. No officer shall succeed herself.

Section 4. Nominations to fill vacancies in office shall be made by the remaining members of the executive committee and acted upon by the Club.

Section 5. The executive board shall consist of the elected officers, the chairmen of the standing committees, and the wife of the president of Ottawa University. It shall meet at the call of the president to formulate the budget, to make recommendations, transact any business of emergency nature and business not of sufficient importance to bring before the Club.

Article V - Scholarships

Section 1. Scholarships awarded by the Ottawa University Women's Club shall be given bi-annually to a woman student, three weeks prior to the end of the first and second semesters. Each scholarship shall amount to \$50. and shall be applied toward tuition.

Section 2. At present, one scholarship per semester shall be awarded. The number of scholarships awarded per semester may increase in the future as the Ottawa University Women's Club treasury can accommodate them. In the event there are insufficient funds in the treasury, the awarding of further scholarships shall discontinue until such time as funds are available.

Section 3. A scholarship may be awarded to the same student as often as the Scholarship Committee sees

fit to do so.

Section 4. The Scholarship Committee shall consider a student for the scholarship if she meets the following requirements:

- a. She must have a grade average of 1.5 or better;
- b. She must establish evidence of a need;
- c. She must have an acceptable personality and a neat appearance.
- d. She must strive to uphold and enhance the fine spirit of Ottawa University.

Article VI - Quorum

Two-thirds of the membership shall constitute a quorum.

Article VII - Amendments

This constitution may be amended at any regular meeting of the Club by a two-thirds vote of the

members present upon recommendation of the
