The Six & Violence is at it again with a brand new concept CD, "Petty Staycheck". Graced with insane sound-effects, humorous

and insightful lyrics, blazing speed, and general mayhem (all trademarks of the 6+V), this is indeed the heaviest Violence yet. The inter-related songs bring to light the all too common mistake of wasting one's life away toiling at a bogus job as a servant to the almighty dollar.

Kurt Violence, the twisted lead singer that spends most of his time hiding on the west coast, explains, "Petty Staycheck has songs about some painful stuff, namely YOUR JOB. EUROPEAN NEWS: SFT Europe has just released the comeback of SXE-legends VISION, "One And The Same" for the European market. This was done in cooperation with PA-based C.I. Records, owned by Jeremy Weiss. The reaction has been very good so far - people like the punky elements of the record a lot and look forward to see Vision on tour with Agnostic Front from December 1st to 19th, when they play Germany, Belgium, Spain, France, Switzerland and Holland. • The famous German producer Bruno Kramm will remix at least one song for the forth-coming NECK-full-length. This is the 1st time ever, that a NYHC-band has worked with the Dark Wave / Industrial-based producer. Be warned: the final result of the complicated studio-work will blow your ears off! Bruno Kramm also plays keyboards in his own band "Das Ich". This band toured in the U.S. two times so far, including clubs like the Limelight (1994), CBGBs and The Bank (1997). After signing a majordeal in the summer, Das Ich will tour the USA, Canada and Mexico again for sever-

Europe al weeks in 1998! • There are some interesting tours throughout Germany/Europe this Fall/Winter (besides A.F. / Vision): China Drum; Bosstones; No Fun At All; Bloodhound Gang; Extreme Noise Terror; Helmet; & Lagwagon. GangGreen was cancelled as far as we know, along with H2O, who would have been on tour with A.F. After touring the US in the remainder of 1997, H2O will go to Australia, Japan and Hawaii in early 1998 and then come to Europe for 6-8 weeks. Also, H2O will play the 1998 Warped Tour. • The name of the new Strain CD, released on a German label, is: "Bomb Wedemark!" Wedemark is a German town and the hometown of Lost + Found Records, a label well-known in the US for releasing strange records and merchandise. • SXE-veterans UpFront just released their 1st album in nearly 10 years on the Berlin-based label, Grapes Of Wrath (which is part of the MAD / Coretex empire). The record is called "Movement" and contains 18 songs. • Agnostic Front will release a new EP in Germany to support the forthcoming tour. It'll contain 3 songs, which will also be released on the new CD but on the EP, Roger sings in Spanish! The record will be released in late November/early December and will be available in 3 different colors & 3 different sleeves, 1000 copies each. It's sold out already! Most of the copies were ordered by Lost + Found. • Belgium-based I Scream Records will release 2 interesting compilations early next year (January 20th) titled, "Overload" and "Digital Zero". In the U.S., Victory will release them as one double-CD. Besides bands like Edgewise, Eightball, Better Than A Thousand and Snapcase, "Overload" will contain songs from 25 Ta Life and VOD ("Short Fuse" / "DTO"). "Digital Zero" will feature NRSV and Fahrenheit 451 ("Planet Of The Dead" / "Settle") as well as Integrity, Cause For Alarm, Despair and Next Step Up. • That's the European News, and I'm Udo Meixner!

### RECIPES

When you're a bigtime record company like SFT, you have to learn the "Tricks of the Trade." You know stuff like, how can 2 people eat for 3 days for around \$7.00? Check out what Mad Monkey made for dinner tonight:

#### Monkey's Minestrone Stew

#### YOU'LL NEED:

- 1 cup chopped onion
- 3 large cloves garlic, minced
   That means chopped up real small ya dummy!
- 1 TableSpoon of vegetable oil
- 30 oz (about 4 cups) of vegetable "broth" (AKA tomato sauce and water)\*

- 1/2 cup of dried pasta shells or rotini.
- 1 teaspoon of dried Italian seasoning, crushed
- 1 cup of broccoli florets
- 1 (6oz) can of tomato paste
- · 2 cups of cubed tofu
- 1 (15oz) can dark red kidney beans (we love Goya "oh boy-a!"), rinsed and drained
- Shredded parmesan cheese
