- 2. Sketch a map showing the main geographical features of Exodus.
- 3. What elements of good narrative-plot are made obvious in ch. 1-5?
- 4. What basic question does Pharoah raise, ch. 5:2? How is this question echoed in 5:22-6:1?
- 5. Of what importance is 5:22-6:9 in the structure of Exodus?
- 6. What value has the word "hand" as a symbol? How is "hand" used in Exodus 1-18?
- 7. What do the Egyptians, Pharoah, Israel, Jethro come to know according to Exodus 5-18?
- 8. How is the expression "harden the heart" used to dramatize the theological tension in Exodus?
- 9. Considering their position (ch. 7-12) and arrangement, what significance have the ten plagues in the structure of Exodus?
- 10. What aspects of the Tabernacle project are outlined in Exodus 25:1-9? (Compare with 35:4-36:7).
- 11. In what order are the several parts of the Tabernacle presented in Exodus 25:10-31:18?
- 12. In what order are the several parts fashioned (36:8-39:31). And in what arder are they assembled (39:32-43)?
- 13. In what order is the Tabernacle set up (40:1-33) and with what effect (40:34-38)?
- 14. What is the function of ch. 32-34 in the structure of the book?
- 15. How do the dramatic accompaniments of the giving of the Decalogue contribute to their theological and ethical significance? (ch. 19, 20).
- 16. What are the most distinctive features of the Book of Exodus?
