The occasion of calling the meeting was the burning of the university building but took place and jan 9 last. The fire was supposed originate from a defective Furnace a statement was made by Sec. of the conduit of the Building at present.

The windows, doors, v Shove furniture had been saved.

That immediatly after the fire the Ed, committe writ the aid of the people of Ottawa went to work to save the walls by reproofing joinsling v petitions all of which had been done at are expenses of about \$1200. That the ex committee had exchanged 80 acres of the selected lands for the lumber use their restoring ^ so saving building.

On motion the Board approved of the course taken by the Ex count, v refiner the contract entered into us the exchange of the land per the lumber.
