Y. M. and Y. W. in Joint Meeting Addressed by Prof. Groner.

The Christian associations did not hold their regular meetings last Sunday morning, but instead a general student meeting, in line with the afternoon meetings of the week, was held in Olympian hall. A goodly representation of students was present and a deeply devotional spirit pervaded the meeting. Prof. O. S. Groner had charge and discussed the

topic, "The Student's Relation to the Christian Life," in a masterly and forceful manner, showing the reasonableness of seeking the true Christian experience, and its necessity to the student in interpreting rightly the physical and intellectual phenomena of the universe. He likened the student to a builder whose bricks were the things of his daily life, his actions, the things that he learns, and the cement his Christian thought and aspiration.
