OTTAWA college continues to enjoy the favors of fortune. This time she has smiled upon us in giving to us Prof. F. W. Colegrove as our college president.

President Colegrove was born in Clinton New York, December 17th, 1855. He studied at Whitestown Seminary, entered Colgate Academy in the fall of 1877, and was graduated therefrom in 1878. In the year following he entered Colgate University and was graduated in 1882. After spending one year in Hamilton Theological Seminary, he became, in 1884, principal of Marion Collegiate Institute, which position he filled with great credit to himself and profit to the institution until 1889, when he was called to the chair of Latin and Literature in Colgate University.

Last year our board was so fortunate as to obtain his consent to become President of Ottawa University.

President Colegrove comes most highly recommended as a man of superior character, scholarship, and intellectual force, withal peculiarly endowed with executive ability and eminently fitted for such a place as he now occupies.

His coming among us has inspired us with confidence and raised our hopes for the future of the institution.
