My work for the past year has been
as follows -

During the Fall Term I taught
five classes - Junior German numbering
ten members - Soph. " "
thirteen " - Freshman French "
twenty " - Junior Literature "
twelve " - and The English Profs.
in Grammar numbering twenty six.

During the winter the
same classes were continued with
slight variations as to number.

In the spring term the Senior
Profs. had Literature in place of the
Juniors otherwise the work went
on as the previous terms.

With a few exceptions the work has
been well and cheerfully done.
The classes in Literature have given
considerable time to reading outside
of the text books. I have also had a
class in Bible Study through the
year and in this the work
has been very unsatisfactory
owing to the book used, the fact
that this study is an extra and

considered a burden by the students.
If the Bible is worth studying it
should be given a place as other
studies are and not crowded in,
It should also be restricted to two
or three years of the College Course
proper.
