Dear Dr. Smith:-

The following is a report of the events held at Ottawa University under the supervision of the Physical Education department. Spring 1928.

State Class B. Basketball Tournament, March 15, 16, 17. There were 150 boys from 18 schools from different parts of the state on the Campus from one to three days. cost the college about \$70

County track meet April 24 including 7 schools with about 65 boys on campus all day, cost college nothing.

State Sectional Elimination track and tennis meets, May 4-5, this was one of the biggest meets in the state including 160 boys from 35 schools from the Eastern part of the State. cost college about \$25-\$30.

Play Day under the supervision of Miss. Macaulay at which there were 36 girls on the campus two days. no cost to college.

Track meet between Ottawa and Garnett high schools bringing about 50 boys here at no cost to the college.

A total of 460 high school students brought to the campus at a cost of about \$100.
