Death of A. E. Lunceford A. E. Lunceford, head of the O. U. department of education from 1922 to 1931 died at his home in Flagstaff, Arizona, May 22, of heart failure.

At the time of his death he was

teacher in Arizona State Teachers College. During his career in Ottawa, Mr. Lunceford guided hundreds of Ottawans into good teaching positions. For that reason and many others, his friends among Ottawa grads are legion. He was also known throughout educational circles of Kansas.
