a Ph.D. degree from the University of Chicago, June 8. His studies were in the Humanities Division, department of New Testament and Early Christian Literature. He wrote his thesis on "The Concept of Life After Death in Judaism from the Close of the Writing of the Old Testament Canon to the Close of the Writing of the Talmud."

Anderson has been teaching for two years in the Ottawa department of religion. He did his undergraduate work at Bethel College, St. Paul, Minn.
