

Martha Stoltz to Chanuté

Martha Stoltz, '21, a teacher in the biology department since 1927, has resigned her position at O. U. to accept a similar one in the Chanute, Kans., junior college.

After graduation from O. U. Miss Stoltz taught one year in Lost Springs, Kans., and two years in Mulvane, Kans. She then went to the University of Iowa one year receiving her M. A. degree in 1925. While there she earned membership in Sigma Xi, honorary science fraternity. She accepted a position in the Tulsa, Okla., high school and held it until coming here in 1927. In the summer of 1931 she attended the University of California at Los Angeles.

While here Miss Stoltz has been a highly respected instructor and has been justly popular with the students. She has been a cooperative member of the staff, assisting the administration in many important ways.

Miss Stoltz has earned for herself a fine place in the science world. She has been a member of the American Microscopic Society and of the Kansas Academy of

Science, serving the latter organization for some time as a member of the publication committee.
