Today (13 Nov 85) in his home, Paul Schilling (author of the recent THE FAITH WE SING) gave me this hymn, describing it as "more helpful, day by day, than any other hymn as I approach my own death." (A famous theologian, comentor of Martin Luther King Jr.'s PhD, he's not a Hospice patient, but he is in his mid-80s and in noticeable physical decline but of radiant spirit.)....The music is only five years old; sorry, I have no further information....The hymn is by a United Reformed pastor in Britain. We ran into his reputation there in May. Originally from Holland, he's a master of seven languages, and adapted from Swedish this meditation on the scripture noted.
