Meeting of The Faculty of Ottawa  
University, September 11 1915.

Opened with prayer by the President.  
Members present: Messrs Price, Wilson,  
Brown, Higgins, Kimmel, Hardy, Mc-  
Clain, Schabinger, Kingsbury, Ritchie,  
Stansell, and Misses Pincus, Brown  
and Sheator.

Minutes of the last meeting  
were read and approved.

The President made some brief remarks  
on Christian Education and on the purpose  
of an institution such as Ottawa University.

Three new members of the Faculty, Messrs  
Ritchie, Kingsbury and Schabinger were  
introduced.

There followed informal discussion of  
the schedule for the first semester.

Voted on motion of Profs. Higgins and  
Stansell to refer to the registration com-  
mittee with power to act the position  
in the schedule of German 2.

Voted on motion of Profs. Higgins and  
Brown to add to the schedule a two  
hour course in English Literature at 10.20  
and a two hour course in Public Speaking  
at 2.30.

Voted on motion of Props. Higgins and Brown that the President inform Mr. Clarence Schmidt who failed in one half his work last semester that the college rule prohibiting his return is suspended.

Voted on <sup>recomendation</sup> motion of Miss Brown that Miss Laura Bradley who failed in two subjects last semester be allowed to re-enter the Academy. Also, that Howard Rainer who had 1 condition and 1 failure be allowed to return. Also, that Chester Roberts who failed in one half his work be allowed to return and enrol conditionally.

Voted on motion of Miss Brown that Bert Andrews <sup>was</sup> be allowed to take plane geometry out of class on account of a conflict with regular studies.
