It is also recommended that the tuition fees be adjusted in accordance with change of terms and the suggestion of Prof. Stewart Viz. \$12. for first term, \$9. for second term and \$9. for third term - or \$25. for the year - in advance. That the arrangement of courses of study be referred to the Faculty.
