for one hundred dollars when the following action was taken

Resolved that B S Lamberson of Lawrence ce to pay to J S
Emory one hundred dollars which said Lamberson subscribed
to Ottawa University provided the said Emory will give the Trustees
a receipt in full and demands a certain note made to his order &
placed in the Simpson Bank for \$600⁰⁰ on which a number of the Trustees
are held personally for which note we authorized a deed for 120 acres of
land & Resolved that we agree to release said Emory on a certain
note made & placed in the 1st Nat. of this City on which his name stands
as security & we will further aid in raising in the Lawrence Church
the balance due him viz (\$80) &

Resolved that H F Sheldon & B R Croford be and the same is
appointed a Committee to go to Lawrence and make a settlement
with Mr Emory on the above basis

June 14 1878-The Ex committee met in the office of the Sectary

Present Holt, Summer, Croford, Sheldon, Topping & Atkinson.

A communication from J.S. Emory addrefed to the Secty, wad read on which Mr. Emory asked for an order on Mr. Lamberson for one hundred dollars when the falling actions was taken.

Restored that B D Lamberson of Lawrence to pay J S Emory pm hundred dollars which said Lamberson Subscribed to Ottawa University provided the said Emory will give the Trustees a receipt in full and surrender a certain note made to his order & placed in Simpson Bank for \$600.00 on which a member pf the Trustees are held personally for which note we authorized a deed for 1120 acres of land. Restored that we agree to where said Emory on a certain note made & placed in the 1st day of this city on which his name stand as security & we will further aid in rasing in the Lawrence church the balance due xxxx xx (\$80) &.

Restored that H J Sheldon & L R Croford be and the same is appointed a committee to go to Lawrence and make a settlement with Mr. Emory on the above bars.
