The Trustees of Attenu University met at  
the house of J. S. Emory. Present Robt. Allinson, Jones  
& Allinson. After duly Opening the Meeting the  
Minutes of last Meeting were read & approved.

The Pres. J. S. Emory presented a paper  
which was in the form of a Memorial to the  
Secy. of the Interior requesting him to stay all  
proceedings in the execution of the law passed last  
June. After the reading of the paper it was adopted  
and ordered to be signed by the Pres. & Secy. and  
forwarded to the Secy. of the Interior.

The Matter of Opening the School was  
brought up and considered. The Trustees  
expressed a desire to have the White School go on  
but would not hold themselves or the Society  
responsible. But if one thousand Dollars could  
be realized out of the sale of survey block over  
expenses & claims on the same they directed <sup>the Treasurer</sup> to pay  
the same to M. L. Wood in addition to the donation  
he might receive and that he could occupy the  
School building with himself and family.

The Matter of the Indian School was next  
considered. The Treasurer was instructed to have  
the School opened & provided with a Teacher &  
to make provision for all Indian children who  
might come.
