PRICES TO GO TO ENGLAND

PLAN TO SAIL ON THE S. S. ANTONIA FROM MONTREAL, CANADA, JULY 26.

Will Visit an Indefinite Time With Son in London—May also Continue Trip to Visit Daughter in Mandalay, Burma.

President and Mrs. S. E. Price have completed their plans for an extended trip abroad this summer. They plan to leave Ottawa early in July, visiting in Chicago and Rochester on their way to Montreal where they will sail on the S. S. Antonia, Cunard line, for London, England, on July 26.

Dr and Mrs Price will visit their son, Clair and his family who are living in London. They expect to stay there for an indefinite length of time. If Dr. Price's health improves as rapidly as he believes it will with his release from all responsibility, it is highly probable that he and Mrs. Price will go on to visit their daughter, Miss Hattie Price, who is in Mandalay, Burma.

It is their plan while in Asia to make a study of the mission fields, especially of the mission schools. They have, however, made no definite plans for this part of their trip.

Dr. Price is glad to say that his trip to England has been made financially possible by friends in Ottawa, whose names he is not permitted to make public. The Prices have made arrangements to sell their home in Ottawa to the board of trustees of O. U. Their household goods will be sold the last of June.

Without any obligations on this side of the water Mr. and Mrs Price feel that they will be able to stay in London an indefinite number of months before making further plans.
