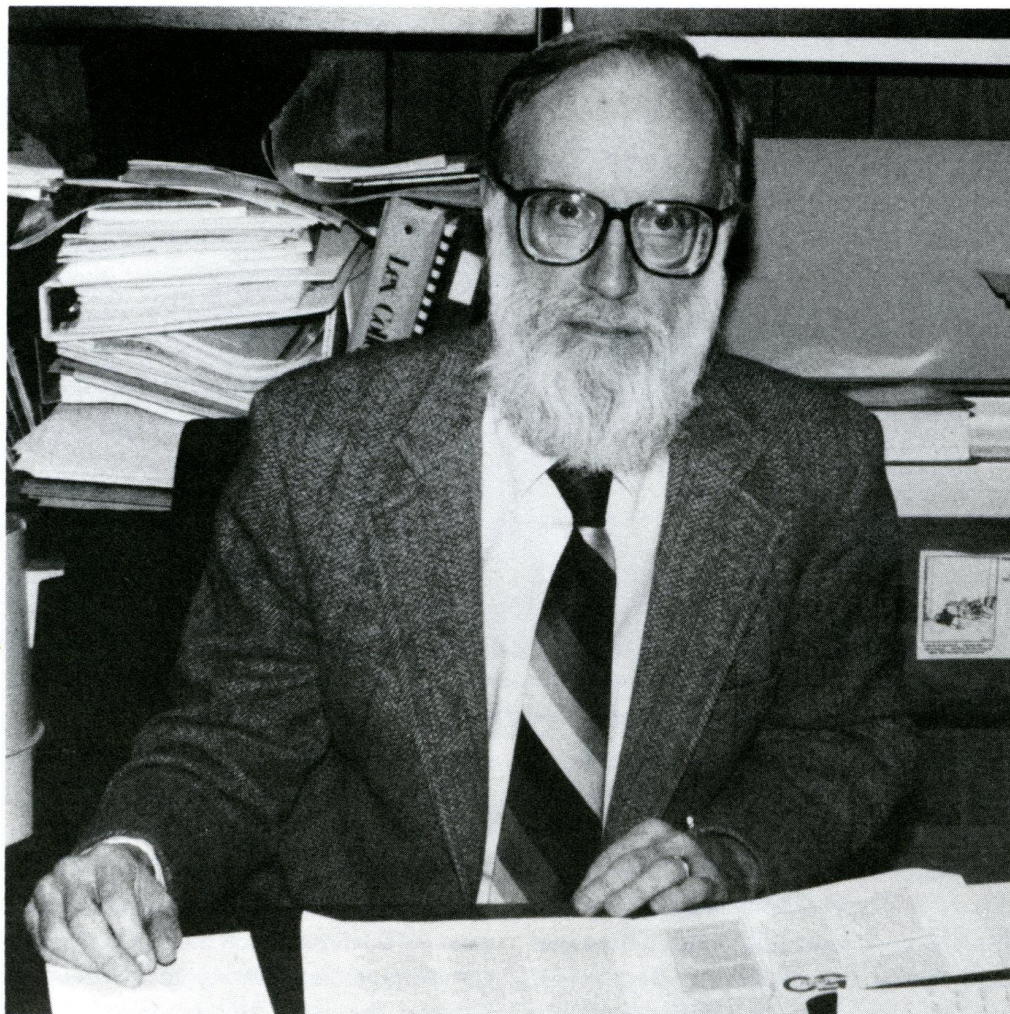


Academic Dean to resign

OU Enrollment Increases Again

Student enrollment on the Ottawa University campus continued to climb this fall semester, as Campus Provost Steve Markwood announced in September the total enrollment at the Ottawa Campus is 545. This is the seventh consecutive fall semester increase, with small but consistent surges. The 1991 fall enrollment was 540.

"The increase in enrollment is especially rewarding given the current uncertainty of the National economy and the significant shift of new student interest toward community colleges," stated Markwood.

The most significant increase of 8% occurred among students living in University residence halls.
