Miss Vincher presented the report for its committee on the girls request for credit for work in physical culture, Recom-mending the adoption of these regulations: Regulations Regarding Physical Training 1. All college freshmen and sophomores shall be required to take at least 90 minutes a week gymnasium work. 2 Hat Students be given one half hour credit per semester for Their work in physical training, counting such credit among the six hours required outside of the 120 hours of class woon or laboratory work. 3 Basket - ball, foot ball, tennis, base ball hockey, soccer, track and fily athletics may, on the approval of the physical directors, be substituted for gymnasium work, provided that no student may make more than one half hour credit in any one simuter. Excuss from the required work may be granted from month to month for such exercise as may be approved by the prisident and the 4. Not more than three hours credit for physical baining shall be given to any individual student throughout his college earen. 5 All students in the academy shall be pequived to take the same amount
