



JOHN WESLEY'S RULES FOR SINGING

- 1. Learn these tunes before you learn any others; afterwards learn as many as you please.
- 2. Sing them exactly as they are printed here, without altering or mending them at all; and if you have learned to sing them otherwise, unlearn it as soon as you can.
- 3. Sing all. See that you join with the congregation as frequently as you can. Let not a slight degree of weakness or weariness hinder you. If it is a cross to you, take it up, and you will find it a blessing.
- 4. Sing lustily with a good courage. Beware of singing as if you were half dead, or half asleep; but lift up your voice with strength. Be no more afraid of your voice now, nor more ashamed of its being heard, than when you sung the songs of Satan.
- 5. Sing modstly. Do not bawl, so as to be heard above or distinct from the rest of the congregation, that you may not destroy the harmony; but strive to unite your voices together, so as to make one clear melodious sound.
- 6. Sing in time. Whatever tune is sung be sure to keep with it. Do not run before nor stay behind it; but attend close to the leading voices, and move therewith as exactly as you can; and take care not to sing too slow. This drawling way naturally steals on all who are lazy; and it is high time to drive it out from us, and sing all our tunes just as quick as we did at first.
- 7. Above all sing spiritually. Have an eye to God in every word you sing. Aim at pleasing Him more than yourself, or any other creature. In order to do this attend strictly to the sense of what you sing, and see that your heart is not carried away with the sound, but offered to God continually; so shall your singing be such as the Lord will approve here, and reward you when He cometh in the clouds of heaven.



PREPARATION FOR LEARNING

We have, my friends, in John 14, 15, 16 and 17 a remarkable teaching in a prayer which our Lord offers in His last hours on earth. There's great sadness and confusion among them because He has said He is going away. They are dimly aware that this going away will be by way of sorrow and suffering on the cross, which the full meaning will be revealed to them later. In these chapters, Jesus is preparing them for what will take place after His going. It is a deep teaching.

The words "Holy Spirit" are used only twice in the Gospel of John. And the word "paraclete" is described by a variety of words in many Biblical versions. Please turn to John 14:15-18. I am using the New King James Version in this service because I have worked with this translation and am quite familiar with it. This Bible uses the word "Helper". Catherine Marshall wrote a book about the Spirit entitled, The Helper, which is a very helpful book and I'd encourage you to read it. Also read John 14:26. One of the reasons that many of us are ignorant spiritually is because we have not allowed the Spirit to teach us. He is the One who Christ sent to be our Teacher, our Guide, our Counselor.

Now please read John 15:26-27 and 16:7-15. These verses are very significant. There are stages in Christian life when you can't take the whole counsel of God. Part of our problem is that we want the whole; all the truth dumped on us at one time. But there is a progression, a teaching all of our life. The matter of graduation says this. We cannot work on a Masters Degree until we have a Bachelors Degree, and we can't work on that until we've graduated from high school. But somehow in the Christian life, we are not willing to take this to heart.

The word "paraclete" comes from two words. Para Cletus. Para means along-side, Cletus means to call. The Old King James Version uses Comfortor, this translation uses Helper, The Revised Standard and the New International Version (NIV) uses the word Counselor and The New English Bible uses Advocate. There is also an active meaning of this word. Para Kalein, which is interceptor, mediator, spokesman, teacher, helper, friend and consoler. All of these are a gift to us in the person of the Spirit, or the Paraclete.

THE COMING OF THE PARACLETE

The Paraclete comes because Christ asks for Him to come. He is subject to the authority of Jesus. Friends, there is a great tendency today to drive a wedge between the Spirit and the Son. The Father has sent the Son, as the Son has sent the Spirit to do the bidding of the Son, who is always obedient to the Father. This is the triad. They are in agreement on all that is done. There's no inconsistancy in the God-head, there is a unity

that goes beyond any unity we understand. So Jesus is saying this in many different ways. The Paraclete is a gift of God Himself.

There is a difference of my telling you about me in a resume, height, weight, the experiences I've had--you look at this and say, "This is Fredikson". Now many people think of God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit in that same way. But there is a different dimension in which He says, "I will give you myself". This is like my saying to Ruth, whom you know I love dearly, "I give you me"! With all my faults and hangups, but God does not give Himself that way, He gives Himself with all His richness. This is the way we speak of having a first-hand experience with God.

ANOTHER PARACLETE

Please read John 14:16. Jesus was a Helper, an Advocate, a forgiver of sins. He was a Comfortor. He was a model in His earthly life. He was all this to His disciples outwardly. How can He then penetrate within? As long as He stays with us in a fleshly way, we'll always grasp for the flesh. This is why in the garden, when Mary gets hold of Jesus, the physical reality of Jesus in the garden, He ways to her, "Don't continue clinging to me. You cannot go back to that".

So the works of Jesus are what we see in fleshly form. He was a model. He said come and see what $^{\rm He}$ was like. In His flesh He died. This is the powerful point of glory in the Gospel of John. All this He did.

The greatest calling we have, to start with and end with, is to be Christlike. "How can I be Christlike"? I fall, I stumble, I may have said something that was unfair. We all make mistakes, but He takes us back over and over again and He says, "I will renew you, I will refresh you." As Jesus took the disciples in their earthly bodies, He had to teach and reteach them. And He becomes the inner reality of Christ Himself. Another Helper.

NECESSITY THAT JESUS GO AWAY

It was necessary that Jesus go away. This seems like a very hard thing. We cannot cling to the physical Jesus just in His 33 year period on earth. Please turn to the 17th verse of Chapter 16.

The powerful thing about Jesus is that He has finished work. He is doing what the Father asks Him to do. We now come to the next phase, which is really the phase of my glory, making possible the sending of the Holy Spirit. The sending of the Paraclete to us.

So we do not see Him physically that way, as one person. But we see Him in each other. This is another powerful point that Richard Halverson makes. We see Jesus in His word and in the community. So it was necessary that He go so that, at this deeper dimension, He could live with us.

THE CONDITIONS OF HIS COMING

Some people say, "I'm a Christian, I went through the form, I was baptised. But I have never witnessed. I have never felt this life within me, this Christ-form in me, this nature of Jesus within". This does not happen automatically. The assumption we have and believe is the Spirit comes into our life when Christ comes. However the question then becomes, "Will I let Him have His way?. If I insist on living my own stubborn way, doing my own thing, completely living by my own impulses and my own desires, I cannot know the fulness of what Jesus talks about.

This is why it is very important to look at Chapter 14, verse 15. Also verse 23. Brothers and sisters, do you love Him? And if you love Him, do you obey Him? I'm convinced that throughout the Gospel of John that you can never, never separate these. He talks much more about His love for us than our love for Him. But whenever He talks about our loving Him, He talks about obeying Him. And that obedience becomes very, very specific. There may be things that need to be taken care of now by you and me, things that I ought to stop doing that I am doing; things that I am loving that I ought not to love, and things I ought to love that I am not. And in doing this I obey.

When this happens, something spiritually akin to the crucification and resurrection happens within us. This is why Paul says, "I am crucified with Christ, but Christ liveth in me. And the life I live in the flesh I live in the faith that the Son of God, who loves me, gave Himself for me. That's where the power is. He gives me the gift, He has left, that it might be given. The Counselor, Advocate and Helper. He gives me this gift when I meet the conditions.

JESUS: THE TEACHER OF HIS DISCIPLES

Please read the scriptures listed above. In this section, Jesus is having his last conversation with his disciples, and he is preparing them for "going away". It is like a coach who is sending the team on the field and he has two minutes before they go out. These have to be very precious moments. He is sharing with them the best he can give. And in a sense Jesus is sending a team on a field and he is preparing them for going. Jesus says that there are some dark moments that are to come. Death, separation, the feeling of being like orphans skattered; but there will be triumph and exultation in the end. It will be in this that they will discover what it means that Jesus dwells inwardly. Not outwardly and physically, but inwardly.

The things that I am reading today have to do with the teaching ministry of the Paraclete. John uses the word Paraclete, which is taken from two wards--Para which means "along side" and Kletos which means "to call out". There are a variety of definitions given the meaning of the Paraclete; encourager, comfortor, helper, friend, advocate and counselor. And these passages speak of the Paraclete.

Please read the verses in Chapter 14 again, and also the verses in Chapters 15 and 16. In great teaching, some thing of the teacher is given to us. A teacher has a hand in forming my character, my person, and making me something I was not before. A great teacher has a passion to teach and also cares. That's when we learn. Jesus was a great teacher. He wanted to give people spiritual facts. He taught them about who the Father is. He taught them about themselves. He taught them about the kingdom, eternal life, and he gave of himself in such a way that they knew who he was, who he is. And in doing that, he formed their character, he made them into something they were not.

If you take Jesus as a teacher, his style was "to come and see". There is a sense in which the whole Gospel is Jesus saying, "I want you to come and see who I am and where I'm living". Jesus did not bang people over the head. That was not his style. It was not the Apostle Paul's style. It was, "You come and check it out". And when they did this, they saw his teaching and his works, what he said, what he did. He became a model. They saw him at the point where we don't want people to see us.

You can't put thirteen men together and have them living like Jesus without having a sense of their seeing him "undressed", with all his guard down. My guess is that in quiet moments, they told him about the temptations. But he gave them a model. He called them to himself. He said, "You cannot come to me unless the Father draws you and gives you to me." This is the sovereighty of God. Don't you dare think for a minute that you sit in a service like this and turn on or off whether you want the Lord to call you.

That is up to a sovereign grace. The most terrible thing would be if He never called you.

The final act of Jesus' teaching humanly, was that he gave himself. He said that the Son of Man must be lifted up. He was speaking of his own death.

THE FATHER WILL GIVE ANOTHER PARACLETE: A TEACHER

The Spirit that entered Mary and gave her the seed of the Son, the Spirit that breathed into those who wrote the scripture is the Spirit that dwells with me, this is the Spirit of truth. And he says that he will abide with you, he will dwell with you, live in you, and he'll make his home with you, and he will abide with you forever. Now that's a marvelous thing. Jesus, himself glorified, is the Spirit of Truth. He is the one who becomes the Teacher.

This is the one the world received. But "worldly people cannot receive this one because they neither see him nor know him. There's a world of difference between the mind enlightened by Christ with the Spirit open to him, and the worldly, natural man who has never had an encounter with Jesus. Part of our problem has been that we talk to You sometimes, asking You to do Christian things when we've not been given the Christian mend. That only comes when Christ enters us and we're open to being taught and are allowing him to teach us in this way.

You can have a tremendous amount of knowledge of the Bible, without ever being taught by the Spirit. We need to ask the Lord to help us cross that line. The fact that I may know lots of things, have lots of information, be well-trained, be the "best" at my job, does not mean that I know the Spirit.

WILL WE LET HIM TEACH US?

How much do we want him to teach us? If I clog my life with only TV, and if I only take in what they way, or live by my own instincts, there will be no learning of what he wants to teach me. So it calls for a humble Spirit and a teachable nature.

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God. This is a very simple statement. But you live with it. What does it mean to be pure in heart? What does it mean to see Bod. He will teach us what that means if we let him.

He will guide you into all truth. He will take you by the hand and lead you into it, and he will not be doing this on his own authority, he will be doing it on the authority of Jesus, the glorified Christ who will tell him what he is to say to us. We have a pipeline right to the throne of

the Almighty. Most of us work out our salvation with fear and trembling. What it takes is a sensitive spirit, a weighing of all that he tells us.

Friends, we need to spend more and more time with this Book. The Spirit that breathed life into these words, is he going to breathe those words into us until they become a part of our existance? I would beg of you again if you take life seriously, to live with the scriptures and let them become a part of your very existance. I think we have to do this in the community of believers. That's why we need Bible Study groups and discussion in Sunday School classes. This is why a husband and wife need to talk with each other. This is why we need to have changes when we can share, "This is what he said to me, I've got a question about this, and I think I want to tell you this about the scripture".

You can only know the Truth and the Spirit if you obey. If \underline{I} obey. He will tell us all things we need to know, and he will do it as the inner Paraclete, the One who lives within the Spirit of Truth.



THE PARACLETE: THE ONE WHO ADVOCATES AND CONVICTS

The Scripture

John 15:26-27, 16:8-11, 15:18-21

Another Paraclete

- Necessary that Jesus depart so the Paraclete can come.
- He comes because Jesus asks the Father to send Him.
- 3. He continues the ministry of Jesus within the disciples as Helper, Counselor, Enabler, and Teacher.

He (Paraclete) Will Bear Witness To Me 15:26-27

- 1. And you also are witnesses.
- 2. Because you have been with Me.

When The Paraclete Comes, He Will Convict The World 16:8-11

- l. Of sin because they do not believe.
 - 2. Of righteousness because I go to My Father.
 - 3. Of judgment because the ruler of this world is judged.

The Servant Is No Better Than His Master 15:18-21

- The words and works of Jesus unmask the sin and hatred of the world.
- So there will be hatred and opposition for the faithful disciples.

I will be reading three passages of scripture and hoping that somehow the teaching will come through clearly. We have for two weeks, talked about little about the meaning of the one who comes after Jesus has returned to glory with his Father. The word for that in this Gospel if "paraclete". It's important to understand that this realify, this one who comes is so great and wonderous that there is hardle any human word that can cathh up the dynamic meaning of who he is. But as we've said wach week, Para means along side and Kletos to call out. So we've used words like Helper, and Counselor. and Advocate, Encourager, Teacher. We talked quite abit last week about H m being our Teacher. I'm taken with this more and more that when we become in Christ His Disciples, He is eager to bring to our remembrance all the things that He has taught us. And therefore, our whole pilgrimage of discipling can be a time of growth and wonder. A child, like little Christine who committed herself last week, or an older person like some of the Deacons. None of us need way I will not or cannot grow. For He is our Teacher, not outwardly, but inwardly. And He teaches us what Jesus tells Him to teach. He is not off on His own, He is teaching us what Christ tells Him to.

We think of this week. What could happen if each of these teachers, and I believe that this is their desire, long to let the Spirit teach through them. So the youngest child, two years of age or whatever, or a sixth grader will somehow at that level learn to understand who Jesus is and know about Him.

Now this Paraclete is given because Jesus asks the Father for Him to come. He has said it is necessary that I go away, because if I do then this one can come and dwell within. And he will not be someone outside you, he will not be in flesh, so to speak as I have been, Jesus says. But He will dwell within you and will be your inner encourager and guide and strength.

Now He has prefaced this, we have talked about this earlier, by saying, if you love me and keep my commandments. I pray that throughout this congregation in every heart there's a sense of love for Him, if we know $H^{I}m$. And that we long to obey Him. XXXXXXXXX

Yesterday as we were coming home, Ruth and I, and by the way we've had a wonderful week for which we thank God, we prayed together and laughed together, we have read the scripture together, we have been with some dear, dear friends who are a part of the Fellowship Of Christian Athères at a national training conference. And coming home yesterday at the Indianapolis Airport there was a dear couple who were trying to obviously keep their grandaughter who neme we found out was Lynn in toe. And Grandma kept saying, you sit on the shair; I said to myself if Grandma really understood where Lynn was, six years of age, but she stayed on the chair.

They talked because we asked them if they had been to the zoo. Her folks live in New Hampshire where they lived for nine years. And as we got ready leave the little girl, Lynn, put her hand out, she literally did. And then she did like this, and all I could do is pick her up. And when I did, believe it or not, she gave me a smack right on the mouth. And the Grandmother said she doesn't know a stranger.

As I came down this morning, I thought that's a very simple thing. But wouldn't it be a marvelous thing if we could say Lord I love you! And I want to stay on the chair because you told me that, or I want to keep my dress clean because you told me to. I want to do what you want me to do because I love you.

It's on that basis friends the Spirit enters our life. He not only has a mission for us in encouragement and teaching, but he has a mission to the world. And that mission can be put under two headings out of the scripture:

1) He is an Advocate, like an attorney who speaks for Christ, like a counselor who bears whitness; 2) and He is one who convicts the world. You cannot separate these two.

Now if you will, look at the 15th Chapter xx of John and verses 26 and 27. But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send you from the Father, the Spirit of truth (this we talked about last week), who proceeds from the Father, (the truth of the Father men and women, cannot be separate from the truth he gives us). That's an incredible reality. He says, He will testify of me:

Everything the pirit does in **s** sense through us to the world is an opening up, a revealing of who Jesus is. He testifys of Him. The one major thing the Spirit has to do, one of the two things with the world, is to make Jesus evident. So that as Jesus walked the earth and the Spirit was in him, when the Spirit enters us Jesus starts to become evident through us, because he goes on to say

And you also will bear witness, because you have been with me from the beginning.

We cannot divorse, brothers and sisters the reality of the truth that is in us from the witnesses born to Jesus through us as we go about our lives. And we cannot say, friends, the witnessing will be done on Tuesday night from 7-9. Or it will be done from 11-12 Sunday morning. Or it will be done at some particular time. I saw this with fresh clarity. We say so easily that we're witnesses all the time, but on what basis. You do not become a witness because I say "go out and be witnesses", Say something to someone about Jesus, "etc. Or here we've go t a program, or memorize these 18 points and so on.

You become a witness because **when** the Spirit Jesus enters you, and you are eager to speak of H m. There is no other way it happens.

Friends, 30 years ago, a young coach drove from Oklahoma to Pittsburgh, you have heard me speak of this before, because he had a dream that athlets could stand up, professional, ameteur, high school, college, could stand up and say I'm not askamed to let you know that I'm a Christian. Now it's 30 years later, and Ruth and I for a few hours had the opportunity of being with about 35-40 of whats called A National Board. I must say as we climed on the plane to come home, I was filled witha kind of joy, I wish I could convey to you, that strong men and women, unashamedly speak with one another about Jesus.

Take a man names Joe Rogers from Nashville. Who had just sold a construction company that was based on three continents. He didn's speak much about that, he Baid I want to tell you about the bible study group I'm a part of in Nashville in my church. I want to share what's taken place in my life. I used to smoke 3-1/2 packs of cigaretts a day. The last cigarette I had was 20 minutes before I had a heart attack on a plane flying. Flying believe it or not overseas. I was just coming home from Greece. And out of that experience, he waid, I met the Lord.

Now there's no way you can divorce the experience of Jesus living within him in the Spirit from the whole fabric of his life. He said I wish my wife could be here because of so and so forth.

Here's a man nam ed Clindon Thomas, some of you may be old enough to remember that way back in the hay-day of the Wilkenson teams, Bud Wilkenson said to nine men on that championship team, you're going to Estes Park. It wasn't a matter of will you go, you're going! He said Clindon did, there had been struggle, anomacity and jeolcy on that team, but something happened to us at Estes. And we came home ix different people. That was 30 years ago. And they had on the wall on this National Training Center a picture of that group that had been at Estes that first summer. Louis Evenston, Charlie Kalan, Auto Graham, and Bob Feller were men who said, we're give our time to be a part of this movement.

Now I'm not trying to drop names, I'm just saying we come out of a place where people are eager to talk about this. And Clindon Thomas, now a grey-haired man in business in Oklahoma City talks so easily, and naturally abdut Jesus in him life. I wish everyone of us could that. Not because I say it to you. Listen. You've got all kinds of demands and important things you're doing, I know that. Nothing is more important, that somehow into your life has come the Savior and the Lord and by his Spirit witness is made, testimony is made and as I grow in Him, the ultimate thing I can say is, let me tell you about Jesus. Let me tell you again because we have a program at 1st Baptist, it oomes to be because as we read the scripture, he testifies the Spirit of Jesus and you also will bear witness because you have been with me from the beginning. **Ax It's a matter of having the Spirit in our lives and being in touch with Him.

The second He does is He convicts the world. Will you turn now to the 15th Chapter of John and verses 8-11. We read these words:

And when he is come, the Spirit, Paraclete, he will comvice the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because they do not believe; in me;

Listen, the bottom line of sin is not that I did this, and this, and this wrong; the bottom line all through John's Gospel, is that I refuse to believe in Him. That I reject Him. Therefore it's fair to say khak, to quote Paul later, whatever is not of faith is of sin.

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Now that beems like a heavy thing to say. But you cannot take your life and chop it up and say in a sinse there are parts of it where there will by unbeliefe and there are parts where there will be belief. The sin in our lives is unbelief. And the ultimate sin is the rejection of Jesus, and the Spirit convicts the world of that. It Jesus came as a light and the light shines in darkness, the darkness is going th fight back. It is inevitable.

He said, I did not come to judge you. But the very fact that the light shines means the darkness fights back again. You cannot have a positive witness without the negative fighting back again. So he says I convict the world of sin because it doesn't believe and of rightnousness, verse 10 of John Chapter 16, because I go to my Father, and you see me no more; which is to sas, the righteousness is revealed in the fact that Jesus has done His word, gone home to the Father, released the resources of grace in such a way in that in His grace, righteousness is given us. And those who do not believe, who sin in that way, are convicted of that fact that they are unrighteous.

If you sit here scorning today, not knowing the Dord, that's exactly where you'll be. We ought not to leave this church, all of us, feeling comfortable. If there have been great areas of our life which have been areas of unbelief, thex Spirit will convict us of those. And likewise of false righteousness. Our own righteousness.

And finally he says of judgment, verse 11, because the ruler of this world is judged. By all that Jesus did he judged the evil. And that becomes apparent. Because in the victory of Jesus and in the Lord living in our lives, the evil one is judged.

Now this is a very important thing to understand. Friends, you cannot expect if you're faithful in the witness, to win a popularity contest every time. You cannot hake this Gospel witness so smooth that it never leaves anyone embarrassed. Listen, let me use a very simple illustration. You walk into a restaurant and somehow, because your family always does it, you bow your heads to pray. I can tell you that a dozen people in that place who used to pray, but don't now, or who** have never prayed may feel embarrassed by the fact that you've done that.

The only way to keep the thing smooth all the time is to do nothing, which is exactly what multitudes of Christians do. If I never bear witness, is it fair to say that the Spirit is really in me? We've had lots of debates about the tongues and gifts and the Spirit, but with Jesus the basis bottom line is if the Spirit is in you, you will testify of me. Everything else is frosting on that cake, or is butter on the bread. And I long for us, I say it in love that in the Spirit we become a witnessing church and that we testify each of us, home, marketplace, wherever we are to the fact that Jesus is the one who is the Lord of our lives.

The last scripture, and I just refer to it briefly, is back to the 15th Chapter

of John and verses 18 - 21.

If the world hates you, you know that it hated me before it hated you. If you were of the world, the world would love his own:

See the easiest way to live at peace in the world it to somehow "bed down" with it. And if I bed down with the way the world thinks, you can bet your life you'll never be embarassed. But if somehow I say, I will be faithful to Him. I can expect to better, no less than what is given Him.

Add all through this Gospel, fairends, those who do not believe and accept Him are in conflect with Jesus. There is such a thing as a Christian counterculture which says I will not buy everything out there because in the Gospel there's a line drawn between the Spirit of this age and the Spirit of Jesus. And as He knew conflict, my being in Him will mean that I will know it too. This is what He is saying here. For He goes on to say, remember verse 20:

Remember the word the I said to you. A servant is not greater than his master. If they persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they kept my word, they will keep your also. But all these things they will do to you for my name's sake because they do not know him who sent me. It is not that I come and say you are a bad fellow and I want to tell you how bad you are, it is when I say, let me tell you about Jesus. The guy who hitches his pants up and says, what do you mean anyhow? I don't buy it. And I'm being faithful to Jesus, I testify of Him.

Friends, there's something about the Lord's supper that says I'm united with him. I'm not askamed to say that I eat his flesh and drink his booked. That I partake in his grace. That I'm nuttured by him. Because to puck up another verse in John He is the vine and I am the branch, as you are. And I draw my life from him. And in drawing that life from him, I find to my amazement that there's fruit boness

So what do we eat and drink together? We are celebrating our union with Jesus. Which has in it both the joy of the Gospel and the unbelief of those who will not accept him.

I want to step down to this level to say that he is the one who invites us, and we do not come because we are "good enough". We come because by his grace he said I bid you come. And whom the Father gives to the Son, the Son will keep. And in our datting and drinking together, we partake of him, spiritually. But also in some sense as we pass the bread, the cup, we are really partaking of him in some deep physical sense. This is not like another service. I'm reminded, the Lord speaks to me and ministers to me as I take bread and drink the cup. And as Jesus who is head to the church who invites us to come. So the question is not what church denomination you bear, the question is do you love him, and will you obey his commandments. Those who do are welcome, however faulty or frail or weak. Let this be a moment when the Lord cleanses you, cleanses us add fills us with his grace. This is a time of healing. We invite folks who wish to come to with kneel and in prayer to do so. I hope some of you will feel led to do this. There's no magic in this, but it could well be the act of moving and saying, Lord I need you, I ask for your forgiveness, I have physical, spiritual and emothonal needs. That you would come.
