## **Hawley Writes Feature Article for K. C. Star**

A feature article written by Dr. Charles Hawley about the grave of Taui Jones, founder of Ottawa University, appeared in the Kansas City Star January 27.

Taui Jones is buried in an old Indian burying ground northeast of

Ottawa. This cemetery is considered one of the three most historic spots in Kansas. Near the grave of Taui Jones are the graves of the three chiefs of the Ottawa Tribe. A photograph taken by Dr. Hawley accompanied the article. The picture reproduced the tombstone of the old chief. This tombstone is unique in that it has a bow and arrow and tomahawk on it.

One of the traditions of Ottawa University centers around this grave. It is the responsibility of the senior class to care for the grave and to decorate it before commencement each year.
