

Transcription of the 1876 Ottawa Board of trustees' page 72

May 6- The Ex. Committee met at the office of R Atkinson, all present.

It was moved to appoint a committee of three to negotiate a loan of a \$1000 to pay judgment of A B Marion for Attorney fees have held by A Hourelton, and we authorized said committee to make & deliver a mortgage on 400 acres of the 1280 to Secure said loan with the agreement to pay said \$1000 out of the 1st proceeds of the lots. Carried

Explanation- The Patents not having been obtained on the land we have could be obtained & rather than let the property of the University was already signed upon be authorized R Atkinson allowed a mortgage to be placed on his farm for the \$1000 the trustees mortgages to him same Fanson lots as Security ^ 398 which other words was sold to pay the mortgages-

May 22 1876. The Ex, committee met in the office of R Atkinson all the members were present except E Topping. The committee to write on the Christian Church (Holt) reported that Dr Pryle on behalf of the church said they would give only one hundred dollars (\$100) payable in one year. This offer was rejected & Mr Holt authorized to say the Trustees would take \$130000 Report accepted.

The committee recommended to Sub select Bronson University for the picture of the Atchison Church house. Carried

The University building being in an emergency conditions serving to the doors & windows being open it was ordered that an appropriation be made to firmest lumber & pay for closing the opening & Mr Croford was approved a committee to have it done. Carried
