

#### About the Coaches

G. Ben Moor, Head Football Coach, is in his third session with the Braves. A native of Osawatomie, Kansas, Moor lettered in football four years while at Ottawa University and in 1956 and 1957 he was named KCAC honorable mention all-conference tackle. Following graduation from O.U. in 1958, Moor held football coaching positions at Stafford, Lyons, and Olathe, Kansas. Since assuming Head Coach responsibility at Ottawa, Moor has accumulated a record of 16 wins and 12 losses.

Coach Moor joined the University staff in 1966 as an Admissions Counselor and served as Assistant football coach in 1968 and 1969. He has taken graduate work at Montana State University and holds an M.S. degree from Emporia State Teachers College.

Assistant Coach Bill B. Boucek coaches linemen. He also serves as coach of track and field and cross country in addition to his responsibilities as Associate Dean of Students.

Coach Boucek holds a B.A. from Ottawa University, graduating in 1948. He returned to Ottawa in 1953 following successful coaching tenures at Fairview and Anthony, Kansas high schools. O.U. track and field teams have amassed nine conference championships under his guidance.

Bill holds an M.A. degree from Kansas State Teachers College.

Jim Grogan, a 1957 graduate of Ottawa University, has been a public school coach for the past 10 years. He is a physical education instructor at Ottawa Junior High School. Coach Grogan is a veteran of four years with the U.S. Air Force. He and his wife Doris have 2 sons, Steve and Scott.

Coach Grogan will be responsible for the offensive backs, scouting, and specialty teams.

Assistant Brad O'Dea coaches linebackers. An NAIA All-American linebacker in 1967, Brad graduated from O.U. in 1968. He has completed two tours with the Navy in Vietnam and the South Pacific, and has taught and coached at Ottawa Junior High School. He is presently attending graduate school at Emporia State College.
