If you check your personal library, you may find some books that they may be useful in new Myers Library.

Marion Rader Alderman. '41, is chairman of an alumni committee working on the idea that useful books may be secured from alumni.

She talked to the librarian and found that several categories of books can be used; plays, biographies, literary classics, modern history, good modern works in German, French and Spanish, modern essays, history of religion or discussion on the various religions, new books in the useful arts: medicine, engineering, home economics, books about Baptists, art books especially with colored reproductions.

The library suggests that some types of books are not needed: fiction, out-of-date books, text books, paper backs, books in Latin and Greek, and OTTAWANS.
