The Board of Directors
was organized at the beginning
of the year by the election of A. W.
Benson, Chairman and J. P. Stephenson
Secy. Besides the usual routine
of business required to provide
for the conduct of the school, the
following items of business trans-
acted are to be noticed. We have
caused to be executed a quitclaim
deed to W. W. Nelson for a piece of land
described as the East half of the North
East quarter of Sec. 6 Township 16 Range
19. The nursery which for a number
of years has been in the hands of
A. Willis ^{and} by the conditions of the
lease, began to yield an income
last year. The amt. of ^{the} rental was
fixed by Arbitration at \$75.00 per
annum for five years from the 1st
of April 1881. The insurance which
we have been carrying upon
the building expired last year. The
amt. was ten thousand dollars. Five
thousand of that amt. has been re-
newed, at a cost of one hundred
dollars for three years. The deed of the
land belonging to the American
Baptist Home Mission Society - 160
acres, has been delineated. The
present lease of the University farm
will expire the first of March next.
