RE: Faculty Action on K.C. Center Task Force

The Ottawa University faculty authorized the creation of a task force to assist in the program design and development of a yet-to-be-named Kansas City center of the university. The task force's responsibilities included acting in behalf of the faculty as necessary to respond to immediate needs and program opportunities. Consistent with the title "task force" the life of the group was limited and it had specific reporting responsibilities to the faculty as a whole. We had some expectations that at the time of its scheduled "self-destruction" in May 1975 a more appropriate group with changed functions might be ready to be established. The task force, however, was still useful — and no replacement seemed in order last Spring — so we gave it another year of life.

Basically the same situation still exists. Although the CWC has grown in size of staff and numbers of students, the task force serves a valuable function as a program council and liaison body between the two campuses. The CWC staff is large enough to serve in regular weekly meetings as a kind of academic council and C.A.R. for CWC matters -- but the advisory and supportive and communicative functions of the program council (task force) are still needed.

For the reasons above, the faculty is asked to support the following motion and give the program council (old task force) another year's lease on life. We do not yet suggest that this be a permanent body because of the rapid growth of CWC and the possible need for some other permanent group or groups. Personnel presently on the task force would continue their appointments and vacancies would be filled as needed.

The motion:

"The College Without Campus Program Council (old task force) is to continue to exist through the academic year 1976-77 with its same responsibility and authority as before. The current members of the task force are re-appointed for the year subject to their willingness to serve and the need to fill vacancies. The program council will report to the faculty in November 1976 and April 1977."

Recommendations from Academic Council on Basic Skills Program

- 1. The developers of the Basic Writing and Reading Improvement programs are charged to propose to Academic Council and the facuity "minimum performance standards" by the end of the first year of implementation.
- No more than one enrollment for Basic Writing and one enrollment for Reading Improvement may be counted toward graduation in a student educational plan.
- 3. Credits in Basic Writing and Reading Improvement must be over and above the customary thirty-one course minimum (effective with the entering class in 1976).
- 4. The Academic Council expresses its intention to recommend to the faculty, on the basis of the recommended "minimum performance requirements" for writing and reading, policies concerning either prerequisites or graduation requirement or both.
