Dr. Edgar D. Kerr, professor of music, Mrs. Ruth Kerr, instructor in organ and public school music and Dr. Roy W. Browning, professor of education and psychology, will retire from the O.U. faculty at the end of this academic year.

All three had retired from full-time service three years ago, but since then have been serving the University on a part-time basis.

Having received his bachelor of music degree from the Chicago Philharmonic Conservatory in 1928, "Prof" Kerr attained his masters in music from the Conservatory of Music in Kansas City in 1941. He has served on the O.U. faculty since 1928.

His wife, Mrs. Ruth Kerr, received her B.A. from Ottawa University in 1930. She has served on the faculty staff since 1944.
