

Bob Schendel Passes Symbols of Office to Wilbur Wheaton

Wilbur Wheaton, '52, of Lawrence is the new president of the 'Alumni Association. He was installed at the Alumni Banquet, May 30, by retiring President Robert Schendel, '36.

In the annual mail election, Frances Balyeat Cochran, '20, Kansas City, was elected vice-president. She will become president for the 1960-61 year.

Wheaton is the first president to come up through the vice-presidency. He was elected to that post in 1958, served last year, then automatically became president.

This "move-up" plan was adopted in a vote by alumni in 1957.

At the time of his election he was a teacher in Wichita schools. This year, however, he will take graduate studies in mathematics at University of Kansas under a National Science Founda-

tion scholarship.

During his vice-presidency he learned of the activities of the association, so he is already familiar with his duties.
