



MEDIA COVERAGE

Ottawa University sports fans can follow the Braves' action in several ways. You can read daily stories and features as Scott Hollister reports all the action in **The Ottawa Herald**, or for a weekly summary, look to Ottawa's weekly paper - **The Ottawa Times**. The Braves also will be covered by student reports in OU's student newspaper, **The Campus**. Upon completion, the University's own student radio station, **KTJO 88.1-FM**, will carry live play-by-play of all home and away football and basketball games. Reports on OU sports events also are carried on **KOFO-Radio**, **1220-AM**..**OU RADIO**.

Coverage of OU sporting events has increased statewide to include such major newspapers as the Kansas City Star/Times, Topeka Capital-Journal, Lawrence Journal-World, Wichita Eagle-Beacon, Hutchinson News, and the Salina Journal.

SPORTS INFORMATION

The Ottawa University Sports Information Office is a student organization headquartered in Room 203 of the Administration Building. An extension of the Public Relations Office, the Sports Information Staff is responsible for reporting results from OU athletic events to the media and to conference and district headquarters. They also take statistics at various athletic events, issue news releases and feature stories about University athletes and athletic performances to hometown newspapers and radio stations and prepare the programs for OU sporting events.

Sports Information is part of the greater University Relations Office and is under the direct supervision of Jeff Myrick, director of

public relations.

Scott Fast, a senior from Brighton, Colo., is sports information director, and Mike Smith, a sophomore from Carbondale, Ks., serves as assistant.



COACH DAVE DALLAS

Dave Dallas is in his first year as head coach of the Braves. Dallas previously was defensive coordinator at Graceland College in Lamoni, lowa where he also served as recruiting coordinator. Dave is a native of Herculaneum, Mo. and earned his bachelor's degree at Missouri Western State College. He is currently pursuing a master's degree at Northwest Missouri State University. Dallas, who is excited about the new coaching position, said, "I've always wanted a head coaching position and I'm hoping to bring excitement and enthusiasm to the football program, the community, and most of all, to the institution."

FOOTBALL OUTLOOK

Coach Dallas looks to this year with a lot of new faces backed by veteran players. Top returners include Clifford Boatwright, who earned All-Conference honors last year at the defensive back position. Boatwright broke his own school record last year with nine interceptions. Quarterback Brad Basel will be at the helm for his senior year and sophomore tightend Jim Anderson, another All-Conference selection, will be back again this year. With so many new faces and new coach, the Braves will be looking to surprise a lot of teams in the conference this year.
