## The Walls We Build Worst Views of Walls

### ① In Berlin

- Frieda Gorkh and our friendship.
- The difficulties she has spoken of.
  - Two currencies, Two telephone systems.
- Now the Wall.
  - At first they would speak to each other.
  - Then! "Now the Wall that separates us grows higher and longer. We cannot see our friends any longer."
- This is representative of a Great Wall across the World: The Iron Curtain.

### ② The Great Wall of China

- 1500 miles long, 25 feet at bottom and 15 at top.
- Begun in 200 B.C. Completed in 1300 A.D.
- Thousands of peasants worked 10 years to complete the Wall.

### ③ We Grow A Fence or A Hedge.

### ④ We Put Up A Sign "For Whites Only"

### ⑤ We Use A Derogation Word and a Wall Is Built.



# These Walls Are Of The Heart And Mind

## ① The Walls With Others

- To shield us from those beneath us.
- Apprise people we do not understand.
- When our feelings get hurt.
  - People that have not spoken kindly for years.
- In the intimacy of our homes.

## ② The Walls Within Ourselves

- We hide the kind, sensitive, ideal heart of ourselves from others by a wall.

## ③ The Wall Between Ourselves And God

- We become cold and Indifferent - Shut off.
- We are guilty within - Hostile and we resent.
- Suffering comes and we grow bitter.

This is the Deep, Tragic Wall.

- Adam trying to hide.
  - The rapport is gone.
- Like Between Cities and Nations or like between Lovers.

① The Meaning of This Wall

- Wall between the outer and inner courts of the Temple.
  - Jewish people used in to worship while the Gentiles were kept out.
- The curtain separates the Holy from the Holy of Holies.
  - Man was kept out - God was in there.

② Being Outside The Wall

- Separated from Christ -
  - No <sup>personal</sup> knowledge of God.
  - No real possibility of forgiveness.
- Strangers to the Community of Man
  - We do not belong.
- Outside God's Promises
- Your Word was a Word without Hope and without God.
  - Eugenia Bruce - Freedom & No Meaning
  - Starr Nilley - Bitter Hopelessness.

### ③ Christ Has Broken Down The Wall.

We cannot get it down. We have built it.

#### - Christ Has Offered Himself.

- By His Sacrifice
- Through His Blood
- One Body on the Cross

#### - The Old Testament Scene

- God is About to Destroy the People in His Anger.
- Moses steps into the breach and offers His life.
- But Moses is Not the Man.
- This is the function of the Priest.
- To bear the sins and make atonement.

#### - So Christ Steps Into The Breach

- The Way Is Opened into the Inner Court
- And Into the Holy of Holies.

### ④ Our Situation - The Living Church - Is Charged

- We Who Were Far Off Have Been Brought Near.
- Peace Has Been Declared and the Conflict is Settled.
- There Is One New Humanity.
- Now You Belong - Fellow Citizens. Homebodies of the World.
