ABBOTT was of a family of distinguished mathematicians,* theologians, and biblical scholars.

"Fie, fie, how franticly I square my talk!"

*Cf. the Anglican priest who wrote a fantasyland work similar to FLATLAND: ALICE IN WONDERLAND. Great leftbrains go on vacation into rightbrain fantasylands. Also, J.R.R. Tolkien's MIDDLE EARTH.

Various forms of upper-Hinduism, especially vedanta, were invading old and New England in the 2nd half of the 19th century. FLAT-LAND is a counterattack--pertinent also to the West toward the end of the 20th century.

As the GUIDE, the West is studying advaita ("non-duality"), and concludes it's "babyish," a deliberate rubbing out of "cognizance even of the number Two."

The KING spouts Krishna-Gita-like speeches of what I call the old implosive Hinduism.

Beginning in 1893 (Chicago World's Fair: THE WORLD'S PARLIAMENT OF RELIGIONS, Chicago: The Parliament Pub. Co., 1893, 2 vols.—which I have in the original edition), under the influence of the West's science, we began to get what I call the new explosive Hinduism, which arrives at "No Dimensions" via identification—with/nullification—of scientific thinking (in the West, a way amicable to the thinking of Pythagoras, Plotinus, Pseudo—Dionysius, Eckhart, Blake, Bergson, Teilhard, and even in some respects Whitehead—Wieman—Aubrey).
