



George L. Sutherland - (1887-1890) taught Greek, grammar, arithmetic, geography and physiology at OU in 1884. He raised funds to lay the foundation for the second building (Administration building) on campus. In 1887 the trustees borrowed money to pay the arrears in teachers' salaries. Six students were expelled. When one of the trustees suggested they reinstate some of the boys he was told "if all the trustees would get down on their knees before us and ask us to take those boys back, we would not do it."³ There were 265 students enrolled at the end of Sutherland's tenure.⁸
