The Struggle is Not Against Flesh and Blood

- ① We often believe The Struggle is Outer.
 - That a War will settle all our Problems.
 - That if you have beat someone down physically, you have won.
 - That you win if you beat a man competitively.
 - The bread salesman in Ottawa.
 - That if you get more things than you have won.
 - That we can beat someone down with our ^{hostilities}

② Our Deepse Wrestling Is Not At This Level
