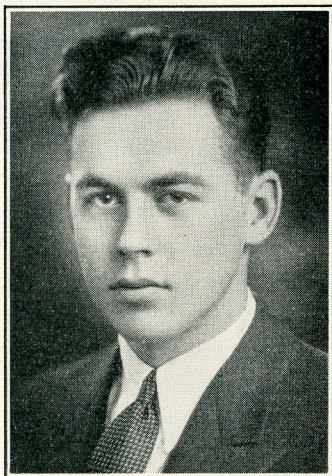

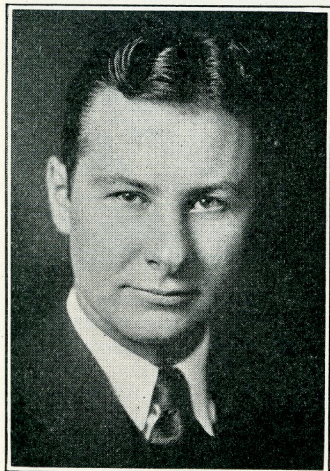


VERYL PITTS

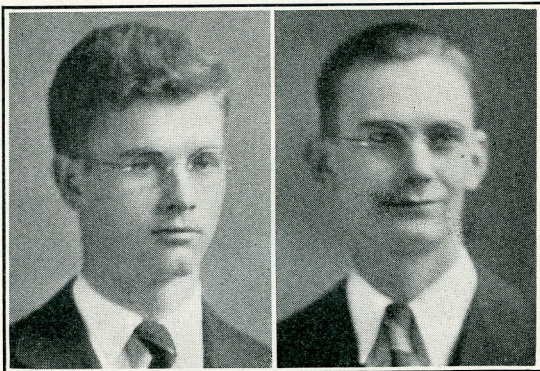
MEN'S DEBATE

Mr. Carlson was awarded first place in Extempore in the Upper Mississippi provincial convention last year.

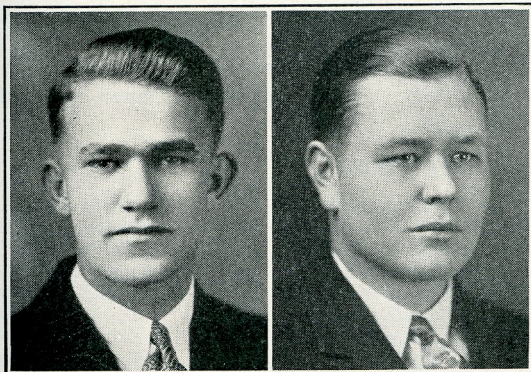

First in Debate

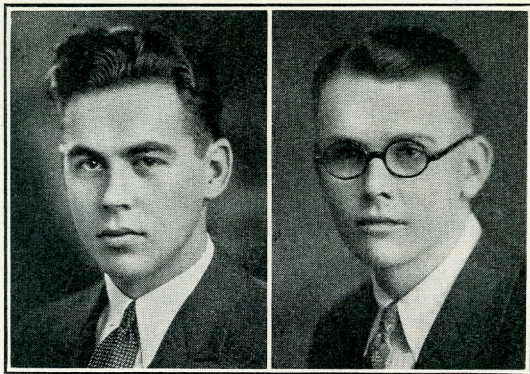


EMORY LINDQUIST LORIN SIBLEY

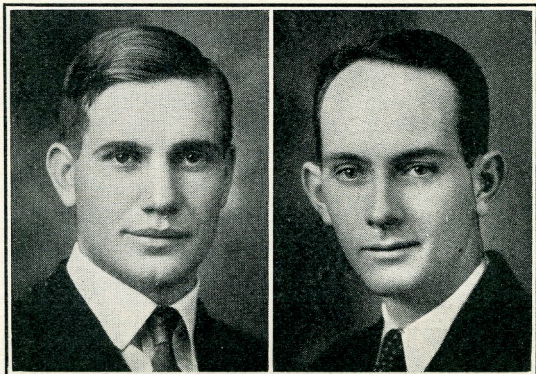
Melvin Nelsen and **Art Larson**, representing Augustana College, tied with Roy McCall and John Ackley of the University of Redlands, for third place in debate.
