#### MEN'S ORATORY

Veryl Pitts entered the University of Wichita in the fall of 1927 and is completing his college course in three years. While his major is Political Science, from his freshman year he has devoted himself assiduously to the study of Speech. He was a member of the debating team at Tiffin, Ohio, again last year in the Kansas and Oklahoma Regionals, and participated in the first two rounds in the Wichita meet.

In addition to his work in forensics, Mr. Pitts has been an outstanding leader in all campus activities. Last spring he was elected president of the Student Council, and this week was chosen a member of the Men's Honor Five. He will graduate this year at the head of his class in scholarship. 

Each of the men has traveled between six and seven thousand miles on debate trips during their four years of college debating.



Melvin Nelsen, a senior, has had four years of intercollegiate debating. He was a member of the Augustana team that went to the semi-finals at Tiffin in


