2007 Audition Procedures and Requirements for Music Scholarships

Audition Procedures

1. Apply for admission to Ottawa University.
2. Submit your Audition Application Form and Audition Time Form at least two weeks before your preferred audition date. Times are confirmed by phone.
3. Scholarship letters will be sent soon after the audition.
4. The Department of Music will recommend scholarships for students who have an interest in participating in the University Concert Choir, Adelante (a select group of highly trained voices), Orchestra, and String Quartet.
5. Students seeking a music scholarship must:
 - Complete and submit a Music Scholarship Application at least two weeks before your preferred audition date, and,
 - Complete an on-campus audition.

Auditions are performed for music faculty or ensemble director, usually during one of the scheduled audition days throughout the year. In certain circumstances, applicants may request a different audition day. **Two solo pieces of contrasting styles** (comparable to the standard repertoire) must be prepared. Applicants should **provide their own accompanist** for the audition as taped **accompaniment is not permitted**. An accompanist may be provided if necessary. The applicant must contact the Department of Music in advance if an accompanist is desired. Auditions may also include sight-reading and/or ear-training exercises. Students receiving music awards are expected to participate in at least one vocal or instrumental ensemble each year and may also be required to enroll in private lessons for their instrument or voice.
