Statement of Faith

- / We believe in God, the Eternal Spirit, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ and our Father, and to his deeds we testify:
 - 2 He calls the worlds into being,
 - 3 creates man in his own image
- 4 and sets before him the ways of life and death.
- 5 He seeks in holy love to save all people from aimlessness and sin.
 - 4 He judges men and nations by his righteous will declared through prophets and apostles.
 - 7 In Jesus Christ, the man of Nazareth, our crucified and risen Lord, he has come to us and shared our common lot,
 - 8 conquering sin and death
 - 9 and reconciling the world to himself.
 - /O He bestows upon us his Holy Spirit,
 - 11 creating and renewing the Church of Jesus Christ,
 - binding in covenant faithful people of all ages, tongues, and races.
 - 13 He calls us into his Church
 - 14 to accept the cost and joy of discipleship,
 - 15 to be his servants in the service of men,
 - 16 to proclaim the gospel to all the world
 - 17 and resist the powers of evil,
 - 18 to share in Christ's baptism and eat at his table,
 - 19 to join him in his passion and victory.

 - 2) forgiveness of sins and fullness of grace,
