

T. M. Stewart - (1881-1883) was a graduate of Shurtleff College and an experienced teacher.⁸ There were only four faculty members, including Stewart, listed in the catalog. The first literary societies as well as a Y.M.C.A. were formed during his tenure. "Rhetoricals" were emphasized as they would be for the next thirty or forty years. Tuition was \$25 a year if paid in advance and there were 54 students enrolled⁵.
