A survey is a process of gathering information. While you are conducting it, you are not looking for a job. What you are doing is informing you self well-enough so that you will be able to make a good decision about where you do want to work.

SURVEY PREPARATION

- A. Subject: state your work interests as precisely as possible
- B. Survey Objective: what, exactly, is it that you want to know
- C. Survey Site: in what specific area or community do you want to work
- D. Off-Site Sources Of Information: list every possible source of information available to you without visiting the survey site.

E. On-Site Sources of Information: list the organizations, individuals, places, etc. you plan to visit

F. Questions to Ask: make a list of the specific questions you want to be sure to ask
