

As the last steel gate clanked shut behind them one day last spring, Dr. Robert Brewer paused for a moment to survey the unfamiliar surroundings.

The walls of Kansas State Prison at Lansing loomed large as he and four debaters from Central Missouri State walked across the concrete yard to start their first debate with the squad of the prison. The members of the audience gave the visitors the onceover as Denis Hare and Mike Bowler took the affirmative on the adoption of a drug program similar to that of Great Britian. Mike Manners and Bud Lovinger, arguing against the adoption of a federally administered welfare system, found the audience responsive and vocal. Manners felt the opposition had tremendous potential.

The Lansing debaters are enrolled in a debate class taught by J. Roger Mortimer, himself a PKD member. Some of the prison debaters already have undergraduate degrees; others are continuing their education.
