 having first expressed their entire satisfaction with the provisions
 thus made for the Education of their Children.

 has been given to us through our Treasurer and
 do pledge ourselves to guard well the Trust committed
 to our care so that both the Indians, and the
 Denomination may fully realize all that they expect from

That we will moved for the Education of their children to an amount not sending three thousand Dollars a year, paid amount to be given when it can realized as entered on money entered on money resend prior the sale of college lands + in the mean time we shall use our influence to get the Baptist House Major Society to provide for their education. This aid to be given when the Chefe because settled on their new Reservation and to continue as long as they remain in their tribe farm. The above to be submitted to the Secretary of the Interior and Sen. Sec. of the Bap. Home majors soc, for there approval, if not approved by both if them the Board would be pee from any of the Hedges given. Carried.
