## The Deans

It is the responsibility of the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences to form the present courses of study, to maintain and improve the scholarship of students, to stimulate the scholarship and improve the methods of teaching of the faculty, to prepare and post the schedules of class and laboratory work, to assign the rooms for class use, to issue permits for the use of the Administration Building for all extra-curricular activities, to arrange for and preside at the Chapel exercises three times a week, to arrange for the programs of Freshman week, and the exercises and programs of Commencement week, and assume perhaps a thousand other duties of lesser importance.

The office of the Dean of Women is indespensable to the life of the University, not only because of the personal contacts made with the women of the campus, but also because of the supervision of all parties given by student organizations and of all group activities. Particular attention is given to all women's organizations by the Dean of Women.

The office of the Dean of Men is meant to be a friendly headquarters for the men of the campus, where there is a genuine interest in the affairs and problems such as health, vocational guidance, personal counsel, and campus activities—the "Chicken Scrap", "Senior Sneak", "Tug of War", and the "Painting of the Dome". The office of the Dean of Men is the medium through which an ideal relationship between the student body and the faculty can be attained.
