



C. O. HARDY

Dr. C. O. Hardy, '04, received his Ph.D. from the University of Chicago in 1916, and honorary LL.D from O. U. in 1935. He has been professor in the Universities of Chicago, Iowa, California, Minnesota, and Ohio. For 19 years, he was a member of the Research Staff, Brookings Institution; in 1942-43 he was Economic Advisor, Alien Property Custodian.

Dr. Hardy is a member of Phi Beta Kappa, Alpha Kappa Psi, and is vice president of the American Economic Association. He is the author of a number of widely

used books on economic subjects. In 1935, Dr. Hardy was a delegate to the International Conference at London, sponsored by the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace.
