REPORT OF SUMMER SESSION

TO THE PRESIDENT:

The following is a brief report of the Summer Session for 1927. The total attendance in all departments is as follows: Arts and Sciences, 104; Music, 26; Total, 130. The gross receipts were \$3299.78. The total expense account including laboratory materials was \$532.84.

For a more detailed report see the report of the Treasurer, a copy of which I am enclosing.

The following faculty members were under our regular guarantee contract: Dr. L. R. Higgins, Prof. O. B. Lowen, Prof. A. E. Lunceford, Prof. A. M. McCullough, Prof. R. H. Ritchie, Dr. W. B. Wilson. Miss Tucker served under a special contract and was paid the sum of \$100. Dr. W. R. Skidmore and Miss Kibbe conducted classes in their departments, namely, Chemistry and Modern Language, and were classified as special tutors. They collected their fees directly from their students and turned over 25% to the Summer Session fund. In either case a detailed account was submitted to the Dean.

While the total enrollment in Arts and Sciences was eight under last year's figure, still we have had a most profitable session. Our students have shown a high degree of enthusiasm, and it has been easy for us to make the work successful.

The Summer Session has conducted Assembly at least once a week, the regular time being Tuesday, at 9:30. The following special speakers have appeared on the program: President Erdmann Smith, June 14; Music Program, College of Music, June 21; Address by Supt. A. F. Senter, June 28; Illustrated Lecture on the Salmon Industry, W. B. Wilson, July 5; Address by Supt. A. M. McCullough, July 12; Address by Attorney B. F. Bowers, July 19; Music Program, school talent, July 26; Bacone Glee Club of Indian girls gave a special program, June 16.

The girls have shown a good deal of interest in baseball and entertained the school with two match games. Two social events were given during the session. First, an all-school reception in the Gymnasium, Friday evening, June 3, and a picnic on Thursday, July 7.

I am writing this only as a general report of the activities of the Summer Session. For a more detailed account of the work see the Treasurer's report or ask me for further details.
