The United Fund is a non-profit voluntary federation which raises funds in ONE campaign for 22 agencies providing health, welfare and recreation services in Sioux Falls.

The United Fund means a better community in which to live and work. Last year, nearly 1 out of every 2 persons received some form of direct service from the Fund agencies, and everyone benefited.

Each agency prepares a budget estimating its requirements for the coming year. Representatives of the organization meet with the United Fund Budget Committee to review their programs and needs. Based on the Budget Committee's recommendation, the Board of Directors of United Community Services then makes the final allocation to each agency.

The cost of operating the United Community Services, including salaries, supplies and other expenses, amount to 3.8 percent of the total raised. Campaign costs are 5.3 percent of the total. This means that over 90 cents of every dollar is available for allocation to agencies.
