Creature-joys new-born each morn, / evening praises, neighbor worth.

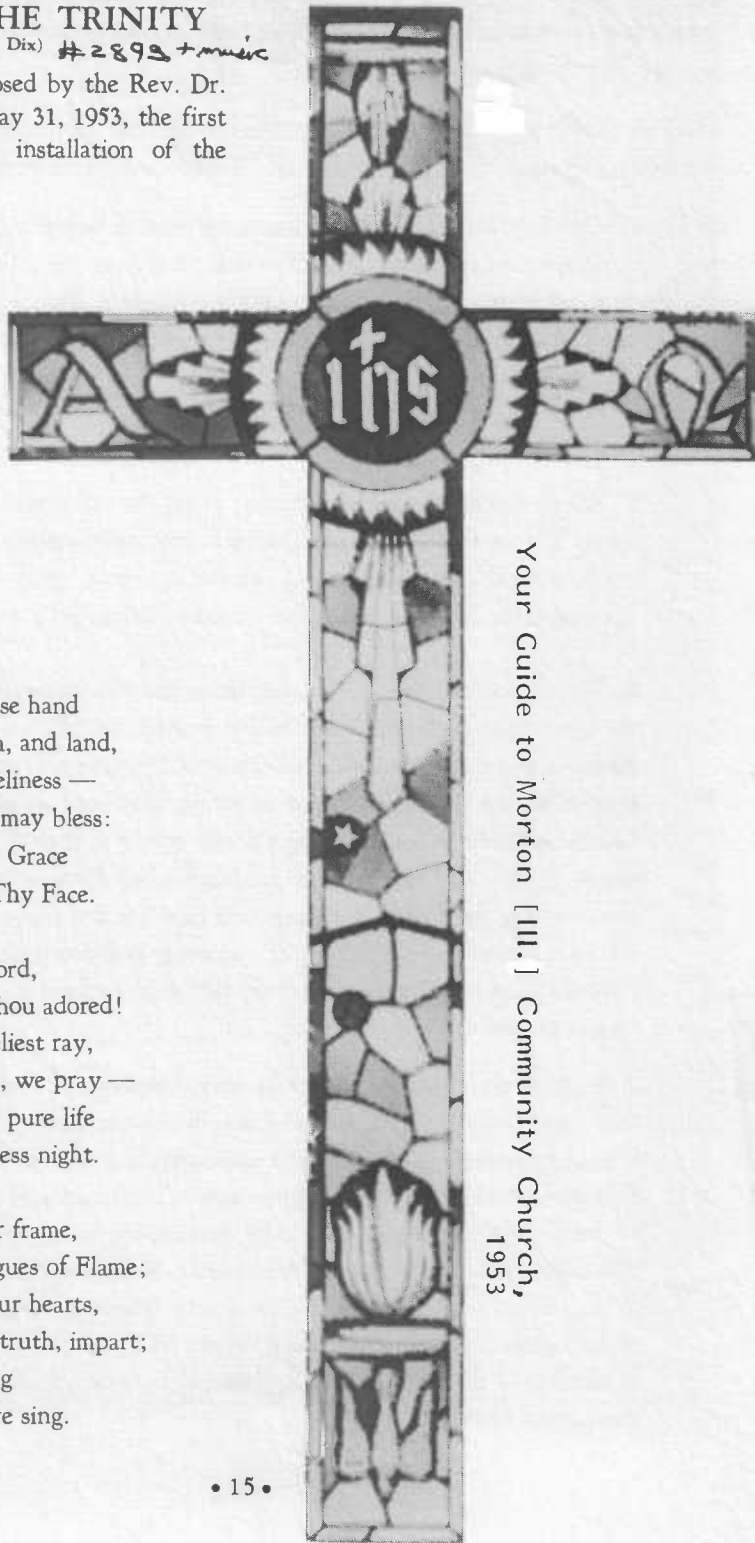
Lord of power, peace, and grace, / welcome us to your embrace;
